Injected systems

Seamless, Invisible, PU Frontal bases

Our systems using injected hair are designed to give a realistic scalp look, they come in a few options - our seamless base which is a thicker silicone base into which the hair is injected in, the Invisible and PU Frontal bases which have a see-through thin PU base. All the above bases can be attached using medical grade adhesive, ghost glue (except the seamless base) tape, microbeads or clips- for a take off solution. A mix of the above is sometimes used also.

We can tailor your system to match your existing hair colour and density for a fully natural looking integration. As we can mix hair shades, densities, root shades, and percentages we can get the perfect match to your hair colour and make you feel like your old self again.

You can do all the things you usually do like sleep in it, go to the gym, swim etc but there is some aftercare for you to follow which is outlined in the main aftercare doc.

Once your new hair has been applied, we will cut in your new style and blend with your bio hair. We will advise you how to maintain your look at home.

The injected base, once washed can be manipulated into place while blow drying on a medium heat, this will help the hair to fall naturally. We ask you to be gentle when washing and styling your injected base, to get the most out of your piece.

Integrated Pieces

Washing

When washing avoid scrubbing at the base. Emulsify the shampoo (mix with water in your hands so it is bubbly) and then place this on your hair with a patting motion. Use a downward stroking movement to work it through your hair- root to tip and rinse in the same way. If your piece obstructs you drying your bio hair underneath, you can clip the length out of the way so you can access the rest of your hair. Repeat with conditioner.

Drying

You need to make sure to dry your piece and the hair underneath fully, as lower heat as possible in order to keep your bio hair safe. If your piece has curl or wave in the hair and you want to keep this, you can leave the ends to air dry as long as you dry the base full and your hair underneath.

Use heat protection where necessary and styling products are fine to use on your piece.

Avoid over brushing when wet, hair is its most fragile when wet and will break the easiest- this is all hair not just the hair in your piece. Avoid overusing tension at the roots.

You can use styling tools on your piece, always use a heat protector and the lowest heat possible to achieve your look. Wash the piece no more than twice per week, if you need to wash your bio hair, you can clip your piece out of the way and wash your bio hair from underneath.

Do not wash your piece upside down as the weight can compromise the attachment.

Do not scratch the base as this will cause hair breakage and bald spots.

Sleeping

As mentioned in the Aftercare document we recommend you sleep in a silk bonnet, or a silk pillow case and loosely tie the hair up in a plait or low ponytail. For frontal systems we recommend you sleep in a headband or scarf tied around the hairline.

Clip in pieces

We recommend you keep your piece on a wig stand, mannequin head or using a front clip (if appropriate) to clip on to something to hang from with the hair pointing in its styled direction.

It's not recommended to sleep in a clip on topper.

Use heat protection where necessary and styling products are fine to use on your piece.

Washing and Drying; Place like warm water in a basin, holding your hairpiece at the front parting area, dip the hair up and down in and out of the water to wet the hair. Emulsify the shampoo and pat this onto the top of the base. Then use the dipping motion to work this through the length and until all shampoo is clear of the base. Repeat in clean water till the piece is free of shampoo. Repeat with conditioner.

You can dry your piece with a hairdryer on a low setting or leave to airdry. Remove the excess water with a towel.

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
